Position Overview:

CDI's Outreach Coordinator supports the organization's visibility, recruitment efforts, and community partnerships. This role builds relationships with individuals, organizations, and agencies that align with CDI's mission. The Outreach Coordinator engages with program participants, supports promotional efforts, and represents CDI at community events. They will work closely with the Program and Operations teams to ensure successful implementation of outreach strategies, follow-up communications, and visibility across diverse platforms and spaces.

Key Responsibilities:

Community Engagement

- Canvassing, community outreach and engagement
- Connecting community to CDI's programs and resources
- Building and maintaining relationships with schools, community organizations, and referral partners
- Representing CDI at community events, resource fairs, and outreach opportunities
- Supporting programming and community engagement events
- Supporting intake efforts for youth and adult participants by collecting interest forms and initial documentation
- Collaborating with staff to identify recruitment goals and make referrals



Communication & Follow-Up

- Maintaining contact lists and outreach logs
- Scheduling and conducting follow-ups with interested participants or partners
- Supporting social media and communications team by collecting photos, testimonials, and outreach content
- Ensuring accurate and timely updates are communicated to relevant team members

- 2-4 years of experience in community engagement, outreach, or organizing roles
- Strong verbal communication and relationship-building skills
- Personable and outgoing to be the public face of CDI
- Experience working with youth, families, and/or system-impacted communities

- Ability to work collaboratively with a team and independently
- Strong sense of initiative and follow-through
- Bilingual Spanish is a plus
